### PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

## **Care Management Services**

Do you know of someone on Medicaid who could use an extra boost of support in obtaining medical services? Our Care Management program may be just what they need!

This program offers support to individuals and families using a person-centered approach to address various needs like physical health, mental health, and substance use. We provide services for youth ages 5-21 and adults with active Medicaid.

Care Managers link and refer qualified individuals to providers in their community, advocating on their behalf so they can receive the care they need. Care Managers assist with navigating the complex healthcare system, and link program participants with affordable housing, food, clothing, childcare, and transportation.

### **New Homeless Shelter**

Did you know our new dormitorystyle shelter, when at full capacity, saves the County and the State \$4,700 each day?

Since opening the shelter on May 8, 2024, the number of individuals in local motels has decreased. At our highest point, we were utilizing just over 230 motel rooms in Chemung County and surrounding counties. As of the printing of this newsletter, only 70 motel rooms were being used, the majority of those being for families.

City, County, and State support helped set up cubicle-style sleeping areas with onsite showers, laundry, and limited storage at 160 High Street in Elmira. The shelter operates weekdays from 4:00 pm to 8:00 am and weekends from 2:00 pm to 10:00 am, providing breakfast and dinner. The shelter's goal is to address the root causes of homelessness and transition individuals into permanent housing.

Last year, 1,357 people, including 317 under 18, received services in Chemung County. These individuals were housed at various motels across multiple counties.
